

Significant events for the month of December, 2021.

A. Project proposed by NITI AAYOG on Ethnographic Study of 226 De-notified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic communities:

- Research Personnel of this Survey conducted fieldwork under the Project proposed by NITI AAYOG on “Ethnographic Study of 226 De-Notified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Communities” across the country.

B. Activities :

- North - East Regional Centre, Shillong of this Survey organized a one day Seminar on the theme “Role of Indian National Army in National Integration” on 21st December, 2021 to commemorate the celebration of “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav”.
- North East Regional Centre, Shillong of this Survey organized a Swacchh Bharat programme on 10th December, 2021 and also organized a Hindi workshop on 17th December, 2021.
- The Head Office and its Regional Centers of Anthropological Survey of India conducted Indoor and Outdoor “Cleanliness Campaign” on 14th and 29th December, 2021 to improve the cleanliness in the office. All the staff members of the Survey participated in this cleanliness campaign.
