Anthropological Survey of India, Ministry of Culture, Department of Culture, Government of India, 27, Jawaharlal Nehru Road, Kolkata invites applications in the given format for the positions of Visiting Fellow - 01(One); Senior Research Fellow - 10 (Ten) and Junior Research Fellow – 16 (Sixteen) respectively. The VF, SRF and JRF will be entitled for monthly stipend of Rs. 40,000/-, Rs. 25,000/- and Rs. 23,000/- respectively and annual contingency of Rs. 30,000/-, Rs. 17,000/- and Rs. 15,000/- payable on quarterly basis. The selected candidate can be posted in the offices of the Survey anywhere in India. The tenure of fellowship is three (3) years which may be extended for one more year in deserving cases.

Anthropological Survey of India, Kolkata invites applications along with curriculum vitae from suitable candidates for engagement of Visiting/Senior/Junior Research Fellows for research work related to projects undertaken by the Anthropological Survey of India.

Format of application form and other details are as follows :

1. Purpose of the Fellowship :

To provide opportunity to research students/scholars to undertake advance study and Research in Anthropology and allied disciplines related to Bio-Cultural sciences.

2. Total Vacancy – Visiting Fellow – 01(One), Senior Research fellows – 10(Ten) and Junior Research Fellows-16(Sixteen).

3. Region wise vacancy – Applicant has to specify name of Regional Centre opting for fellowship. Applicant can opt for only one Regional Centre. Region wise vacancy positions are as follows :

For Visiting Fellow, the place of posting will be at Head Office, Anthropological Survey of India, Kolkata.

4. Date & time of Interview – Eligible candidates will be communicated through e-mail/post.

5. Stipend Rates : i) Visiting Fellow : Rs. 40,000/-
ii) Senior Research Fellow : Rs. 25,000/-
iii) Junior Research Fellow : Rs. 23,000/-

6. Annual Contingency Rates : i) Visiting Fellow : Rs. 30,000/-
ii) Senior Research Fellow : Rs. 17,000/-
iii) Junior Research Fellow : Rs. 15,000/-

7. Eligibility :

- Visiting Fellowship is open to a scholar (Indian/Foreign) of eminence in Anthropology or Allied Disciplines irrespective of their age, as evident from his/her academic achievements and contributions to the respective discipline.
- Senior Research Fellowship is open to persons below the age of 32 years with at least 55% marks in Master's Degree in Anthropology or Allied Disciplines (Psychology, Geography, GIS & Remote sensing, Linguistics, Folk Lore, Museology, Bio-chemistry, Micro Biology, Bio-technology and Archaeology) related to Bio-Cultural Sciences of any recognised University/Institute with at least two years of research experiences and having published work of a good standard.

- c) Junior Research Fellowship is given to persons below the age of 28 years with at least 55% marks in Master's Degree in anthropology or Allied Disciplines related to Bio-Cultural Sciences of any recognised University/Institute.
- d) Age and educational qualification may be relaxed in exceptional cases.

8. Selection process :

- a) Visiting Fellow will be selected through interview only.
- b) Senior/Junior fellows will be selected through a written test followed by an interview. Only those who have cleared written test will be called for interview.

9. Tenure of Fellowship :

The tenure of all categories of Fellowships will be for three years. However, in deserving cases the period can be extended by one more year.

10. Leave :

Thirty (30) days' leave in a year is admissible to a fellow which can be granted by Head of Office. This leave can be suffixed, prefixed and infix with holidays. Three months medical leave without stipend can be granted in cases of exigency and this leave shall be granted by the Director/Head of the Department on the recommendation of Head of Office of the Regional/Sub-Regional Centre's and Officer-in-Charge, Fellowship Programme in case of Head Office.

The women awardees will be eligible for maternity leave at full rate of stipend for a period not exceeding 180 days only once during the tenure of fellowship. However, the fellowship amount for the leave period will be paid after the fellow resumes the duty and submit a medical certificate in support of actual confinement.

- ii) The fellows are required to travel extensively for fields work in target areas of Projects.
- iii) The same Fellowship will not be awarded twice to a person.
- iv) All the categories of Fellows shall be attached to the Anthropological Survey of India, Head Office, Kolkata and Regional Centres of this Survey in different places in India.
